(?) Do you visit your grandparents every week?


(-) You don't visit your grandparents every week.

3- Mary swims in the pool on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

(?) Does Mary swim in the pool on Tuesdays and Thursdays?

(-) Mary doesn't swim in the pool on Tuesdays and Thursdays.



4- The girls wear shorts in summer.

(?) Do the girls wear shorts in summer?

(-) The girls don't wear shorts in summer.

5- I go online once a day.

(?) Do you go online once a day?

(-) I don't go online once a day.



6- Paul helps his mother every day.

(?) Does Paul help his mother every day?

(-) Paul doesn't help his mother every day.
