6. He went to school at St Ignatius College, in London, and later studied art at the University of London. ____
7. He was famous for not liking actors. He once said "all actors are children and should be treated like cattle". ____
8. He was born in Knoxville, Tennessee in 1963. ____
9. He spent a short time in prison because he could not pay a parking ticket. ____
10. His muse was Grace Kelly (later Princess Grace of Monaco), who he directed in several of his most successful films. ____
11. He died in 1980. ____
12. He began his career as an actor. His biggest role was in an episode of the TV series The Colden Girls. He played the part of a man who impersonated Elvis Presley. ____
13. He never won an Oscar for Best Director, although he was nominated five times. When the Academy finally gave him an honorary Oscar he received a standing ovation. He just said, 'Thank you' and left the stage. ____
