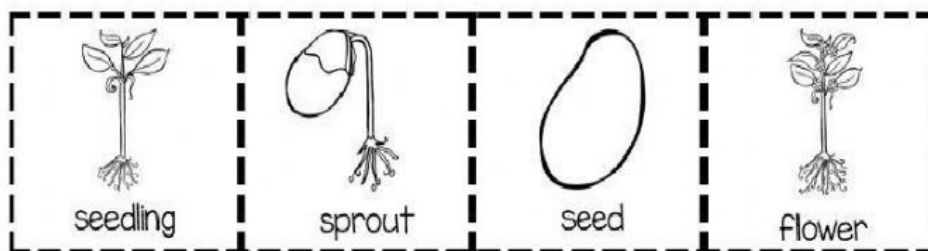
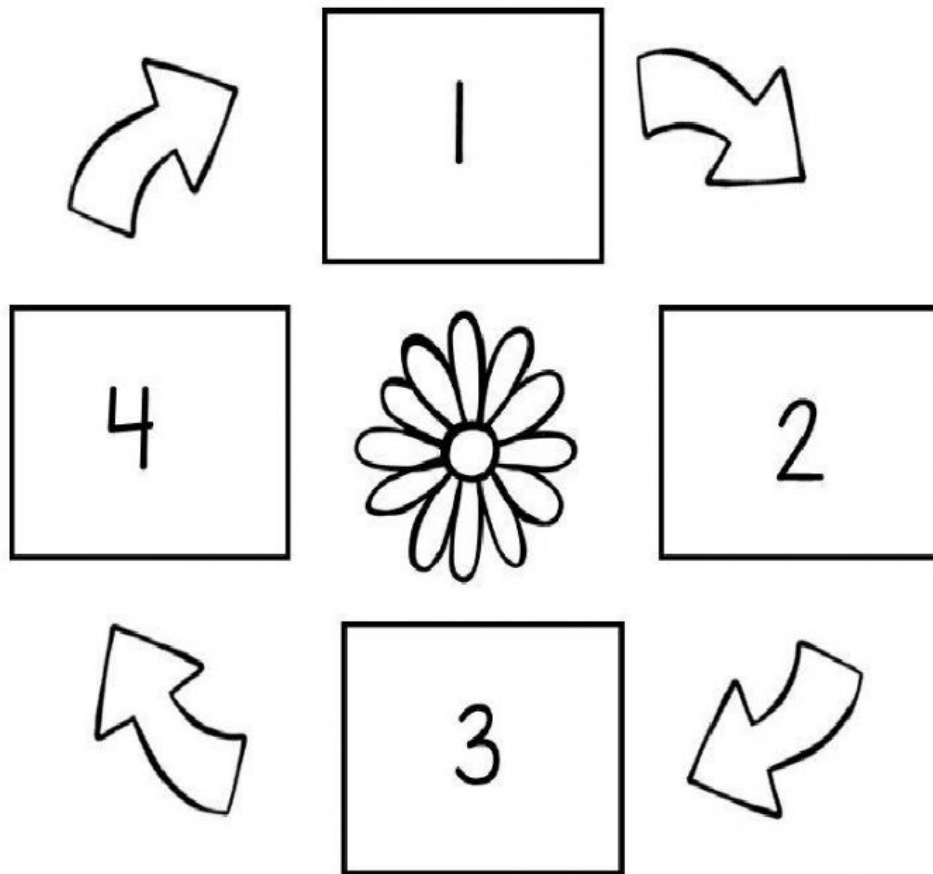

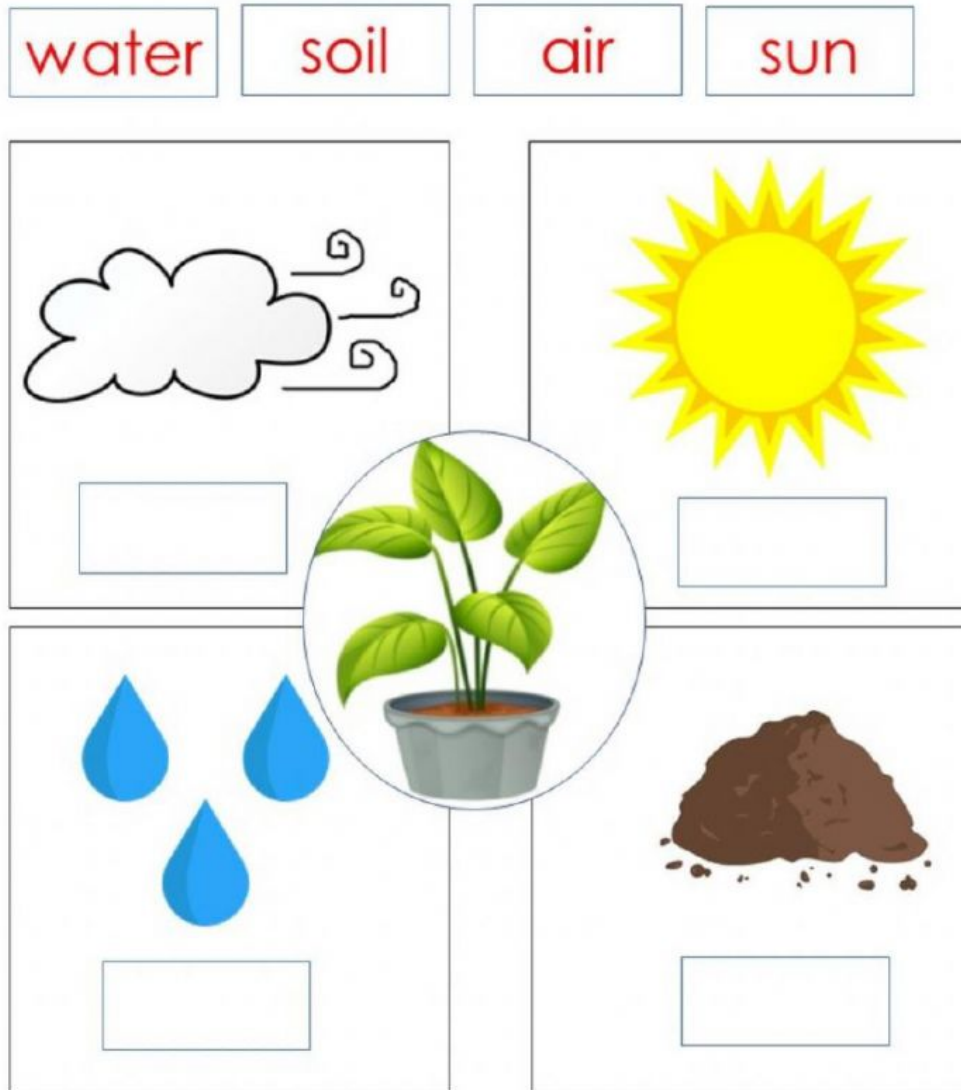
Plant Life Cycle

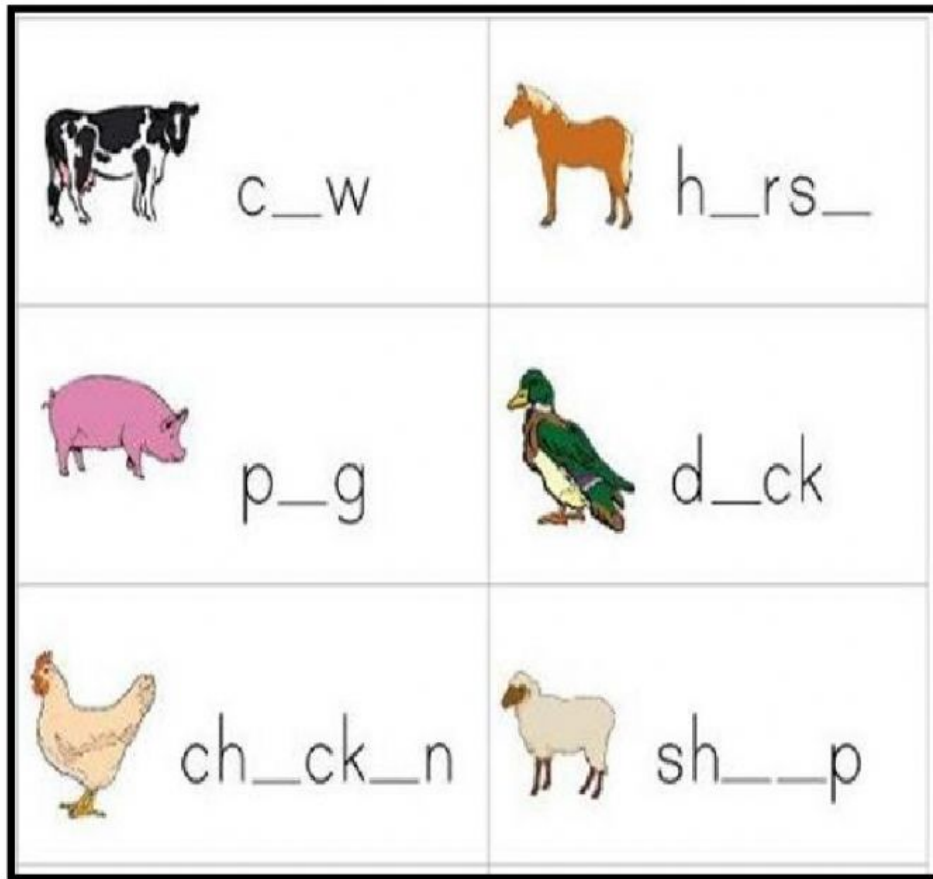
2. What do plants need to grow up a big as they can? Let's practice the things they will need. After this, we're going to play an interactive game about the needs of the plant.
