Pizza is a delicious food you can eat all over the world. Here are some pizza facts.

- Pizza comes from Naples in southern Italy and is **at least** 200 years old. The Margherita pizza, with a **topping** of tomato, mozzarella cheese and **herbs**, is red, white and green - the same colours as the Italian flag!
- The first pizzeria in the United States, Lombardi's in Manhattan, New York, is 110 years old. Now there are 61,269 pizzerias in the USA.
- Pizza is a very popular takeaway food in the USA. 94% of Americans eat pizza regularly - and they buy three billion pizzas every year! That's 350 **slices** of pizza every second!
- A popular pizza topping in Japan is **squid** and a popular topping in Colombia is avocado.
- A lot of men like meat toppings and women eat more vegetables. Chicken is the most popular meat topping for a pizza.
- There are a lot of **varieties**, so you can always find a topping you like. What's your favourite?
