MUST and MUSTN'T (necessity)

Must	Mustn't (Must not)
<p>Use must when you mean 'have to' do something – and it is very important to do it.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "I must study for the test."</p> <p>(2) "You must wear a seatbelt."</p>	<p>Use mustn't when you mean that it is important NOT to do something.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "You mustn't forget about the test."</p> <p>(2) "You mustn't drive too fast."</p>

Mustn't (Must not)	Don't Have To
<p>Use mustn't when you mean that it is important NOT to do something.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "You mustn't forget about the test."</p> <p>(2) "You mustn't drive too fast."</p>	<p>Use don't have to to say that you can do something if you want to – but it is NOT necessary to do it. You can choose.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "You don't have to add sugar to tea."</p> <p>(2) "You don't have to watch that TV show."</p>
