Imperative to use giving a request	Please don't go Please reconsider Let me alone, please

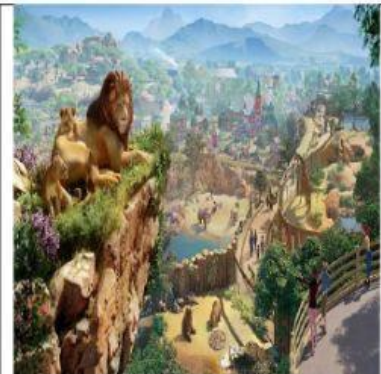
