




Comparisons (1 and 2)

- a To compare two things, we use **adjective + er** [+ **than**]
(old) She's **older than** me.
(cool) He's **cooler than** his brother.
(hot) Today is **hotter than** yesterday.
- b Be careful with spelling!
curly → **curlier**
hot → **hotter**
- c 'good' and 'bad' are irregular:
(good) His English is **better than** mine.
(bad) The weather today is **worse than** yesterday.
- d With longer adjectives of three or more syllables, we use the word, **more**:
(dangerous) This game is **more dangerous** than that one.
