


















## Record bank robbery in Brazil

-  **Branch.** One of many shops or offices that are part of a company.
-  **Copycat.** Done or made to be very similar to something else.
-  **Dig.** To remove dirt from the ground.
-  **Drive away.** To cause or force (someone) to leave.
-  **Encase.** To cover or surround something or someone completely.
-  **Excavate.** To dig a hole or channel in the ground, especially with a machine.
-  **Gang.** A group of criminals who work together.
-  **Heist.** A crime in which valuable things are taken illegally and often violently from a place or person.
-  **Be loaded with (something).** To contain a lot of something.
-  **Spokesperson.** A person who is chosen to speak officially for a group or organization.
-  **Steel.** A strong metal that is a mixture of iron and carbon.
-  **Strengthen.** To make something stronger or more effective.
-  **Suspicious.** Making you feel that something illegal is happening or that something is wrong.
-  **Take place.** To happen.
-  **Trace.** To find someone or something that was lost.
-  **Up-to-date.** Modern, recent, or containing the latest information.
-  **Vault.** A room in a bank, with thick walls and a strong door, used to store money or valuable things in safe conditions.
