### Grammar Rule

When subjects are joined by “**or**” or “**nor**,” the verb agrees with the nearest subject.

### Examples:

- Neither Shayma nor her mother likes going to the dentist.
- Neither the students nor the teacher knows if classes will be held on Saturdays.
