Adverbs of frequency

With the verb *be*, we use this word order: subject + verb + adverb of frequency.

With other verbs, we use this word order: subject + adverb of frequency + verb.

✓ *He is always friendly.*

✗ *He always is friendly.*

✓ *I often watch football on TV.*

✗ *I watch often football on TV.*
