$$\text{RM}20 - \text{RM}3 = \text{RM}17 \text{ (profit)}$$

$$\text{RM}40 + \text{RM}50 + \text{RM}15 = \text{RM}105$$

$$\text{RM}20 + \text{RM}50 = \text{RM}70$$

$$\text{RM}6 \times 20 = \text{RM}120$$

$$\text{RM}4 \times 5 = \text{RM}20$$

$$\text{RM}12 \times 8 = \text{RM}96$$

$$\text{RM}120 - \text{RM}70 = \text{RM}50 \text{ (profit)}$$
