







Most snakes live on the ground.

They use their bodies.
They push hard against the tree.
It is very difficult for them to do, and they take a long time.
They are not very fast climbers.



 Snakes also use their scales.
Scales are small, hard pieces on a snake's skin.
Some snake scales are smooth and flat.
Other snake scales are not smooth.
They are rough.
Scales that are rough can stick to tree bark, so the snake can hold on better.



 Snakes only climb trees to eat eggs or small animals.
