

1 Read the instruction manual. Write the letters (A-J) next to the names of the controls.




The diagram shows the controls of a manual, right-hand drive car. On the left of the driver's seat is the **gear lever** (1) _____. There are five forward gears and a reverse gear. The car is always started in 'neutral' with the **handbrake (parking brake)** (2) _____ is on the floor to the left of the driver. On the floor, there are three foot-pedals: the left-hand pedal is the **clutch** (3) _____, the centre pedal is the **footbrake** (4) _____, and the right-hand pedal is the **accelerator** (5) _____.

On the left of the **steering wheel** (6) _____ there is a lever (7) _____. This operates the indicator lights and the headlight beam.

On the right of the steering wheel there is another lever (8) _____. This controls the front and rear **windscreen wipers** (9) _____ and, the front and rear **windscreen washers** (10) _____.


