TIME WORDS + PRESENT TENSE

- The words *always, usually, often, sometimes, never, every day* or *once a week/month/year* are usually used with the **present simple**.
 - I wash my hair *every day*.
 - I *don't wash* my hair *every day*.
 - My sister *usually does* her homework in the evening.
 - My sister *usually doesn't do* her homework in the evening.
 - They *go* to the beach *once a month*.
 - They *don't go* to the beach *once a month*.
- The words *now, at the moment* and *today* are usually used with the **present continuous**.
 - I *am going* to the water park *today*.
 - I *am not going* to the water park *today*.
 - Jessie *is jumping* on the trampoline *now*.
 - Jessie *is not jumping* on the trampoline *now*.
 - My sister and her friends *are sailing* on a cruise *at the moment*.
 - My sister and her friends *are not sailing* on a cruise *at the moment*.
