

# There is / There are

**Meaning:** To say that something exists (or doesn't exist)

Affirmative +

There is + singular noun

There are + plural noun

There is + uncountable noun

Negative -

There isn't + singular noun

There aren't + plural noun

There is a book on the table

There are books on the table

There is some sugar on the table

There isn't a pen on the chair

There aren't any pens on the chair

We use *there is* for *singular* and *there are* for *plural*.
