*Recordamos como se forman las oraciones afirmativas, negativas e interrogativas. Para eso observa el siguiente cuadro:


Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I'll buy you'll buy he'll buy she'll buy it'll buy we'll buy you'll buy they'll buy	I won't buy you won't buy he won't buy she won't buy it won't buy we won't buy you won't buy they won't buy	Will I buy? Will you buy? Will he buy? Will she buy? Will it buy? Will we buy? Will you buy? Will they buy?
We use <i>will</i> to talk about predictions.	Full forms 'll = will won't = will not	Short answers Yes, I will. / No, I won't. Yes, she will. / No, she won't.


