- What did you do?
 - try to close hole with cloth dipped in oil
- How did you feel then?
 - desperate, terrified, determined to survive, etc.

Para 3

- What happened afterwards?
 - see island, swim to shore

Conclusion (end the story)

Para 4

- What happened in the end?
 - rescued, medical treatment, return home
- How did you feel after the rescue?
 - relieved, happy, thankful
