1 Look at this picture of Bonfire Night.



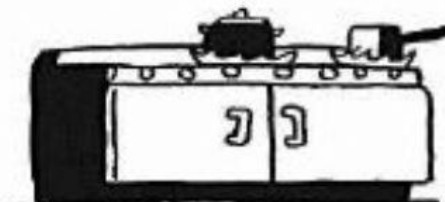
- Make a list of the things in the picture that are storing chemical energy.

- Where is this wasted energy stored?
- Draw a Sankey diagram to represent these changes.
