The 8 parts of speech

1. Nouns - A noun is a **person, place, animal, thing or idea.**
2. Pronouns-. Pronouns are the words you substitute for specific nouns.
3. Adjectives - Adjectives are the words that describe nouns.
4. Verbs-- A verb is a word that describe specific actions, like **running, winning, and being** amazing. Not all verbs refer to literal actions, though. Verbs that refer to as states of being, to **be**.
5. Adverbs - An adverb is a word that describes an adjective, a verb, or another adverb. Take a look at these examples: Here's an example: I entered the room **quietly**. **Quietly** is describing how you *entered* (verb) the room.
6. Prepositions - Prepositions tell you the position or location of a noun or pronoun.eg on, in, above
7. Conjunctions - Conjunctions make it possible to build is a joining word. E.g. and, so, but
8. Interjection - **A word that shows strong feelings or emotions. Wow! Yes!**
