REVIEW: PHONETICS /ED/, PAST SIMPLE AND PRESENT PERFECT

I. *Odd one out*

1. Verbs ending in /d/ or /t/ → add one more syllable: /ɪd/.
Examples: ended, started, calculated, decided
2. Verbs ending in a voiceless consonant (except /t/) → add /t/.
Voiceless consonants: /p/, /k/, /tʃ/, /θ/, /s/, /ʃ/, /h/, /f/
Examples: stopped, asked, reached, teethed, passed, boxed,
finished, sniffed, laughed
3. All other verbs: add /d/
Examples: robbed, mugged, breathed, received, realised, nudged,
boomed, fined, banged, travelled, occurred
