| I <b>did</b> not <b>walk</b> to school. | I <b>did</b> not <b>sell</b> my laptop. |
| <b>Did</b> you <b>walk</b> to school?   | <b>Did</b> you <b>sell</b> your laptop? |
| Yes, I did. / No, did not               | Yes, I did. / No, did not               |

- El **pasado** de los **verbos regulares** se forma escribiendo **ed** al final del verbo en su forma simple para todas las personas. Cuando el verbo termina en **y**, se elimina la **y** y se escribe **ied** al final: study cambia a studied. Cuando el verbo termina en **e** solo se escribe una **d** al final: live cambia a lived.
