


A. Read this text about dinosaurs carefully.

There were many different types of dinosaurs. Many were very big but there were also small ones. The **Brontosaurus** was in North America in the Jurassic period, 150 million years ago. Its neck and tail were long, it was very tall, and it walked on four legs. It was a herbivore so its food was plants. **Tyrannosaurus Rex** was also in North America, but it wasn't in the Jurassic period. The T-Rex lived in the Cretaceous period, 67 million years ago. It was also very big, but **it walked on two legs and had two little arms**. It was a carnivore, so its food was other dinosaurs. The **Velociraptor** also lived in the Cretaceous period, 75 million years ago, but it wasn't in North America. It was in China. It walked on two legs like the T-Rex, but it wasn't big. It was **smaller than a dog and bigger than a cat** and it had claws, feathers, and a long tail. It was also a carnivore, so its food was meat. Scientists think all dinosaurs were eggs laying animals, like birds and reptiles.
