HANA HEGEROVÁ

20. 10.1931, Bratislava – † 23.3 2021, Praha

She was the well-known Slovak and Czech „queen of chanson“ . After completing her primary education in Komárno in 1950, she worked as a clerk for Škoda Works and as a teacher at a vocational school. She got a professional artistic education at the State Theater Conservatory. She first appeared as a singer in Tatra Revue in Bratislava in 1957. She left for Prague where she performed in several well-known theatres such as Semafor, Rokoko.

The interesting fact is that she also appeared in the jazz opera „Dobре placená Procházka“ and the film „If a Thousand Clarinets“. Her broad repertoire included not only Czech and Slovak authors but well-known E.Piaf songs – „My lord“, „Ne me quitte pas“ . She also reached international success in Paris, Olympia but due to the political normalization in former Czechoslovakia, she was forbidden to continue her international performances 1977-1981.

She was awarded several times and after Velvet Revolution, she continued performing more in public. In 2011 she retired from public life and died in 2021.
