The Role of Human Activities in Climate Change

Many scientists believe the main cause of global warming is the greenhouse effect. This is the warming that results when the atmosphere traps heat radiating from Earth. Human activities are changing the natural greenhouse. During the last hundred years, the burning of fossil fuels like coal and oil has increased the concentration of CO₂. Also, the increased amount of land dedicated to agriculture, industry and other human activities has raised the amounts of greenhouse gases.

The consequences of these changes to the natural greenhouse cannot be easily predicted. However, if the present trend in the use of fossil fuels is not reversed, some of the following changes will probably occur:

- The Earth will become warmer. This might benefit some regions, but not others.
- In general, warmer conditions will lead to more evaporation and precipitation. This will vary; some regions will become wetter and others will become dryer.

- The increase in the greenhouse effect will warm the oceans and will partially melt glaciers. Because of this, the ocean water will become warmer, ice will melt and the sea level will rise.
- Higher temperatures and irregular climate patterns will affect the agricultural areas and the quality of natural plant communities.

Some scientists believe that changes in the sun's energy may have contributed to climate changes, but the evidence for this phenomenon is not yet clear. A report from an official panel on climate change, formed by scientists from all over the world, affirms there is a 90% probability that human activities over the last 50 years have caused the climate changes on our planet.
