### SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE



The verb changes in 3rd person singular (he, she, it).  
We add -s  
run - runs eat - eats

Add -es when the verb ends in -ss -sh -ch -x -z or -o  
fix - fixes go - goes  
wash - washes

When the verb ends in consonant + y

cry - cries  
study - studies  
dry - dries

tidy - tidies  
fly - flies  
copy - copies

Example: I go to the beach in summer. (to go) Example: She plays in the garden. (to play)
