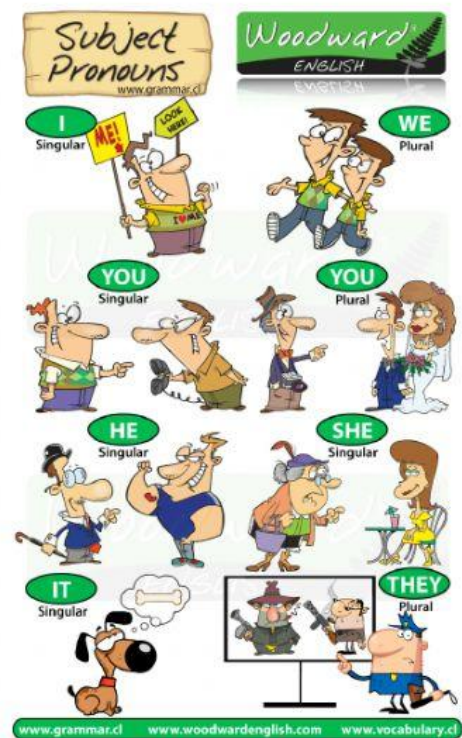


Subject Pronoun

A Subject Pronoun is a pronoun that takes the place of a noun as the subject of a sentence. The subject is the person or thing that performs the action of a verb. Subject Pronouns can be singular or plural, and they can be masculine, feminine or neutral.
