A <u>Subject Pronoun</u> is a pronoun that takes the place of a <u>noun</u> as the subject of a sentence. The subject is the person or thing that performs the action of a verb. <u>Subject Pronouns</u> can be singular or plural, and they can be masculine, femenine or neutral.
