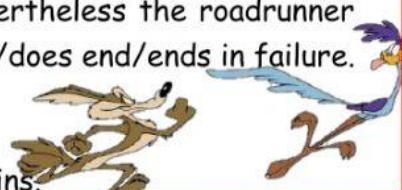
Read and choose the correct answer
