

HOW TO BUILD AN INUIT IGLOO

Watch the video:



Order the steps:

- Build a roof for the entrance.
- Cut snow blocks
- Draw a circle in the snow
- Block the gaps of the walls with snow.
- Remove loose snow from the circle
- Place the second ring of blocks.
- Compact the snow in the walls
- Cut the top part of the blocks so they form an angle.
- Check the circle again
- Continue adding more rings of blocks.
- Build the entrance and get out of the igloo.
- Go outside and fill the remaining gaps on the walls and ceiling.
- Set the first row of blocks, cutting the blocks well so they fit together.
- Cut more snow blocks.
- Place a big snow block on top to cover the igloo.

- Drag and drop the instructions:

Remove loose snow from the circle

Compact the snow in the walls

Cut the top part of the blocks so they form an angle.

Go outside and fill the remaining gaps on the walls and ceiling.

Set the first row of blocks, cutting the blocks well so they fit together.

Build the entrance and get out of the igloo.

Draw a circle in the snow

Place the second ring of blocks.

Cut snow blocks.

Cut more snow blocks.

Continue adding more rings of blocks.

Block the gaps of the walls with snow.

Build a roof for the entrance.

Check the circle again

Place a big snow block on top to cover the igloo.
