- Adjectives are words which describe things, people and places. In English they usually **come before the noun**.
A **big** boy A **pretty** girl A **nice** teacher
- Sometimes they come **after the verb "BE"**.
This boy is **tall**. This girl is **beautiful**. This teacher is **kind**.
- Many adjectives are made from VERBS by adding -ing, or-ed.
- **Adjectives with -ing** describe what something is like.
This book is **boring**. English films are **interesting**.
A **boring** book. **Interesting** English films.
- **Adjectives with -ed** describe how you feel about things.
I am **bored** with this book. I am **interested** in English culture.


