Can + Verb

Use **can** + verb to talk about things someone is able to do.

She **can play** basketball.

Use **cannot** or **can't** + verb for things someone is not able to do.

He **cannot ride** a bike well.

cannot → can't

To ask a question, use **can** + subject + verb.

Can she **play**? Yes, she **can**. **Can** he **play**? No, he **can't**.
