Geographical Features

Beach a large area of land covered with trees and plants, usually larger than

a wood, or the trees and plants themselves

Desert a thick layer of ice that permanently covers an area of <u>land</u>

Forest an area of sand or small stones near the ocean or another area of water

Ice cap a piece of land completely surrounded by water

Island an area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very

little rain and not many plants

Jungle a group or line of mountains with a particular <u>name</u>

Lake a very large area of sea

Mountain range a tropical forest in which trees and plants grow very closely together

Ocean a large area of water surrounded by land and not connected to

the ocean except by rivers or streams

Valley an area of low land between hills or mountains, often with

a river running through it
