

Geographical Features

1. Find the definition

<i>Beach</i>	a large area of land covered with trees and plants, usually larger than a wood, or the trees and plants themselves
<i>Desert</i>	a thick layer of ice that permanently covers an area of <u>land</u>
<i>Forest</i>	an area of sand or small stones near the ocean or another area of water
<i>Ice cap</i>	a piece of land completely surrounded by <u>water</u>
<i>Island</i>	an area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many <u>plants</u>
<i>Jungle</i>	a group or line of mountains with a particular <u>name</u>
<i>Lake</i>	a very large area of <u>sea</u>
<i>Mountain range</i>	a tropical forest in which trees and plants grow very closely together
<i>Ocean</i>	a large area of water surrounded by land and not connected to the ocean except by rivers or <u>streams</u>
<i>Valley</i>	an area of low land between hills or mountains, often with a river running through it
