

REGGAE	A new popular music style popular among young people . They have a good rhythm , a catchy melody , and are easy to remember and sing.
ELECTRONIC MUSIC	A genre of African-American music of the 1980s and 1990s in which rhyming lyrics are “spoken” accompanied by music. It is influenced by rap and funk .
TRAP	popular music of Jamaican origin that combines native styles with elements of rock and soul music. A famous singer of this style was Bob Marley .
HIP-HOP	a form of popular music that evolved in the 1950s from rhythm and blues, characterized by the use of electric guitars.
REGGAETON	music which is made with electronic equipment such as synthesizers or computers .
ROCK AND ROLL	popular music of Puerto Rican origin that combines rap with Caribbean rhythms.
POP	a sub-genre of hip hop music that originated in the Southern United States during the late 1990s. The genre gets its name from an Atlanta slang word which refers to a place in which drugs are sold illegally.
