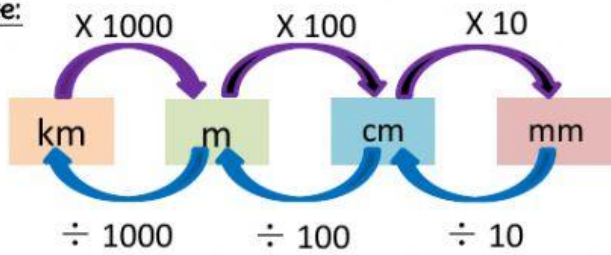


Multiply units of length with 100 and 1000

$$100 \times 0.8 \text{ km} = \text{-----} \text{ m}$$
