Direct and indirect objects

Jason	gave	me	the comic book.			
Jason	gave		the comic book	to	me.	Object pronouns: me, you, her, him, us, them
Our teacher	made	us	a cake.			
Our teacher	made		a cake	for	us.	

The two sentences mean the same thing.

Jason gave me the comic book. = *Jason gave the comic book to me.*

With *make* and *buy*, use *for*. *Our teacher made / bought a cake for us.*
