too much		too much + uncount. noun verb + too much	We have too much free time . You work too much .
too many		too many + plural noun	It's bad to eat too many eggs .
not enough	to say that something is less than we want or we need	(not) enough + noun	I don't have enough energy to work.
		(not) + adjective + enough	She isn't old enough to vote.
		(not) + verb + enough	I don't sleep enough .
enough	to say that something is the correct number or amount	enough + noun	I earn enough money for everybody.
		adjective + enough	This place is big enough for all of us.
		verb + enough	I think I sleep enough .
