


## Rounding to the nearest ten # 1

First, you need to remember that a ten is a group of ten units.

1 ten = 10 units, 2 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units, 3 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units, 4 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units,  
5 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units, 6 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units, 7 tens = \_\_\_\_\_ units and so on.

Now complete the numbers in the number line:



Read and choose the correct options:

Numbers 21, 22, 23 and 24 are nearer to 20 / 30


Numbers 26, 27, 28 and 29 are nearer to 20 / 30

Red is in the middle of numbers 20 and 30; but he doesn't like to go back so he decided to walk ahead to the nearest ten, so Red is going to land in number

**Remember:** To round a number to the nearest ten **you must pay attention in the digit that is in the ones place value**, if it is less than 5 you go back to the nearest ten but if its 5 or more, you go ahead to the nearest ten.
