

Spelling Bee competition

1.- Read the paragraph. Use the words in the box to label the photographs below.

During a Spelling Bee competition contestants are asked to spell words correctly. There is a Master of Ceremonies who reads the words on the spelling list. Once a contestant has started spelling a word, she/he may start over, but the letter or order of

letters mentioned cannot be changed. The judges, who are normally teachers, give points for correct spellings. When a contestant spells a word incorrectly, she/he loses and leaves the contest. The competition is conducted in rounds until only one contestant becomes the winner.
