

Past Simple Tense – **regular** verbs

There are two types of past tense verbs in English.

They are **regular** verbs and **irregular** verbs.

Regular verbs end in **ed**.

Examples – I play. – I **played**. We walk. – We **walked**.

Positive sentences **played** **stayed** **studied** **cleaned** **watched**

Move the past tense verbs into a sentence.

1. I **watched** a scary horror film last night.



2. We **studied** ESOL on live worksheets yesterday.



3. Tracy **cleaned** her kitchen this morning.



4. We **played** football on Saturday.



5. Everyone **stayed** home this month.



Negative sentences

We use **did** in some negative sentences.

didn't = did not

Examples - I **didn't play** outside last week. We **didn't see** you.
The main verb doesn't change in the negative.

negative sentences

didn't exercise

didn't pray

didn't watch

didn't visit

didn't enjoy

didn't call

Move the past tense verbs into a negative sentence.

1. We **our friends last month.**



2. I **my family last night.**



3. She **enjoy the grammar lesson.**



4. I **at the gym recently.**



5. Khlaif **at the mosque last week.**



6. I **watch the news today.**



Questions

We use **did** in some past tense questions.

Examples - Did you **call** your sister? Did you **walk** to work?

The main verb doesn't change in questions.

walk	I walked to work.	I walked to class.	I walked the dog?
stay	I stayed at home.	He stayed awake.	she stayed up late?
work	He worked in a shop.	We worked last week.	you worked yesterday?
wash	I washed the car.	You washed your hands.	he washed the dishes?
kiss	I kwissed my son.	He kwissed me goodbye.	you kwissed my wife?
talk	My mum talked to us.	Tracy talked Spanish.	he talked to you?
pray	We prayed yesterday.	I prayed in church.	you prayed last night?
open	I opened the door.	I opened the email.	you opened the letter?
