

Past Simple Tense – regular verbs

There are two types of past tense verbs in English.

They are regular verbs and irregular verbs.

Regular verbs end in **ed**.

Examples – I play. – I play**ed**. We walk. – We walk**ed**.

Positive sentences played stayed studied cleaned watched

Move the past tense verbs into a sentence.

Negative sentences

We use **did** in some negative sentences.

didn't = did not

Examples – I **didn't** **play** outside last week. We **didn't** **see** you.

The main verb doesn't change in the negative.

negative sentences

didn't exercise

didn't pray

didn't watch

didn't visit

didn't enjoy

didn't call

Questions

We use **did** in some past tense questions.

Examples – **Did** you **call** your sister? **Did** you **walk** to work?

The main verb doesn't change in questions.
