How you pronounce ED depends on the sound it follows.

opened /t/ /d/ /id/      jumped /t/ /d/ /id/

stayed /t/ /d/ /id/      cried /t/ /d/ /id/

danced /t/ /d/ /id/      waited /t/ /d/ /id/

To form a verb in the Past, you need to add .....ed.

When a verb ends in ...e, you simply add d

grade -

live-

phone

like-

When a verb ends in a consonant+y, change y into i, add ed

cry - cried

study-

carry-

hurry-

cry -

When there is a short vowel+a consonant in a short verb,  
double the consonant, add ed. hop - hopped

plan-

stop-

drop-
