You **MUSTN'T** do something.
Don't do it.



You **must** keep it a secret.

You **mustn't** tell anyone.



We **must** be very quiet.

We **mustn't** make any noise.

MUSN'T



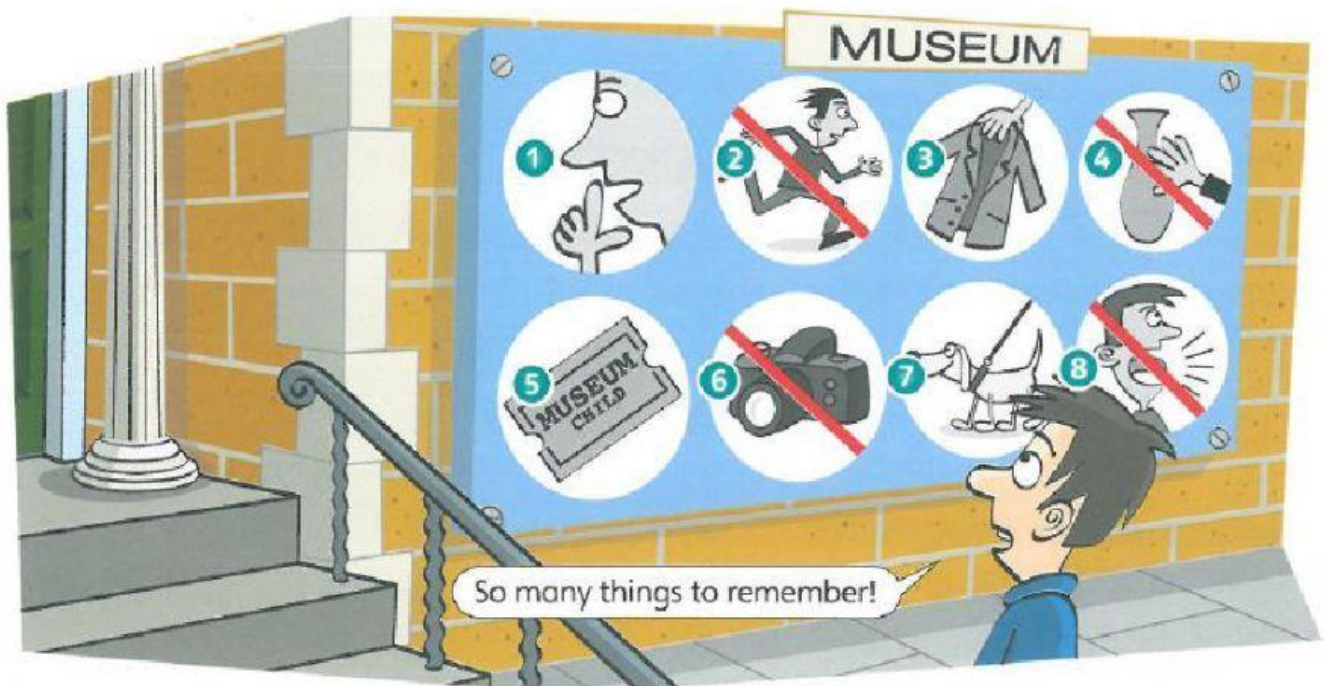
PROHIBICIÓN
