Grammar: Predicates

A sentence has two parts: a subject and a predicate. The **subject** is the naming part. It tells who or what the sentence is about.

Example: The firemen washed the fire trucks.

The **predicate** is the telling part. The predicate tells you what someone or something is doing or did.

Example: Most boys love to play basketball.
