## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

### Rules:

Usually	<b>+est</b>	<i>slow → the slowest</i>
Ending in -e	<b>+st</b>	<i>nice → the nicest</i>
Ending in a consonant +y	<b>-y → iest</b>	<i>funny → the funniest</i>
Ending in a vowel + a consonant	<b>double the consonant + est</b>	<i>fat → the fattest</i>

### I. Write the superlative using “-est” form and the word “the”.
