


OBJECTIVES

Insects and spiders are invertebrates. They belong to a group called **arthropods**. Insects are invertebrates that have **three (3)** body segments; *the head, the thorax and the abdomen*. They also have **six (6)** legs. Most insects have wings and a pair of antennae.



Spiders are invertebrates that have **two (2)** body segments; *the head and abdomen*. They also have eight legs and eight eyes. Most spiders spin silk webs in which they use to catch insects to eat.




