

1	ADD UP	To sum or total a set of figures.
2	CALL OFF	To cancel an event.
3	CARRY ON	To continue to do something.
4	COME ACROSS	Meet or find by chance.
5	COME UP WITH	Produce, specially when pressured.
6	GET ALONG	Have a friendly relationship.
7	GIVE UP	To quit; to surrender.
8	GO ON	Continue; happen.
9	HOLD ON	Wait; stop; endure.
10	LOOK AFTER	Take care of.
11	LOOK FORWARD TO	Await eagerly.
12	PASS OUT	Become unconscious.
13	PULL OVER	Move to the side of the road.
14	PUT UP WITH	Tolerate; endure.
15	TURN UP	Be found by chance.
16	WATCH OUT	To be alert; careful.
17	GO OUT	To date someone.
18	FIND OUT	To discover; learn a fact.
19	TAKE OVER	To take charge; to assume control.
20	BREAK DOWN	To fall apart; to have a mental collapse.
