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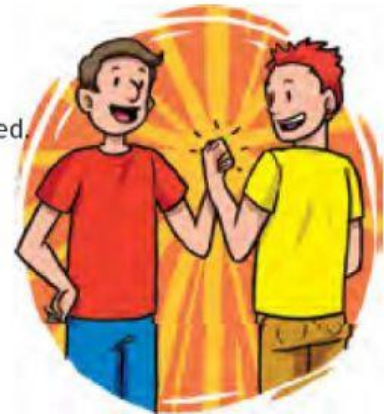

| 6 | GET ALONG | Have a friendly relationship. |
