


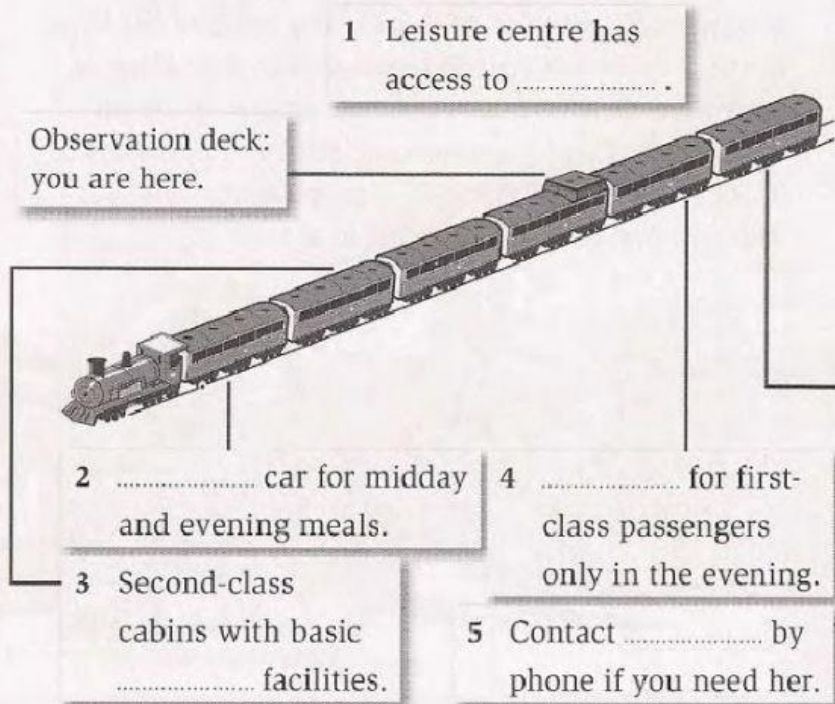

① You are going to hear an information announcement for passengers on a train. Before you listen, look at the diagram below and answer these questions.

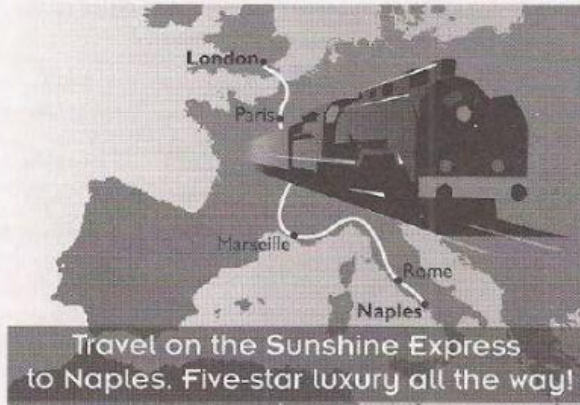
- 1 Where are you on the train?
