1. The present simple and the present continuous tense

1.1. The simple present tense

a. Form

- To be

+	I	Am
	You, we, they	Are
	He, she, it	is
-	I	Am not/'m not
	You, we, they	Are not/ aren't
	He, she, it	Is not /isn't
?	Am	I?
	Are	you, we, they?
	Is	he, she, it?

- To have

+	I, you, we, they	have	
	he, she, it	has	
-	I, you, we, they	do not/don't	have
	he, she, it	does not/doesn't	have
?+	Do	I, you, we, they	have?
	Does	he, she, it	have?
?-	Don't	I, you, we, they	have ?



	Doesn't	he, she, it	have ?
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- Other regular verbs

+	I, you, we, they		work
	He, she, it		works
-	I, you, we, they	do not/don't	work
	He, she, it	does not/doesn't	work
?+	Do	I, you, we, they	work?
	Does	He, she, it	work?
?-	Don't	I, you, we, they	work?
	Doesn't	He, she, it	work?

b. Uses and examples

Uses	Example
General truths and facts	<i>Five times five makes twenty-five. (5x5=25) I really love my family.</i>



Regular and habitual events	<i>How do you get to school?</i> <i>I drink a glass of wine every night before going to sleep.</i>
Instructions and directions	<i>You take the metro into the city centre and then you take a number ten bus. You don't get off at the bank. You get off at the stop after the post office.</i>
Immediate reactions	<i>What do you think about that idea?</i>
I promise, I swear, I agree	<i>I will come back, I promise, when I have time. I agree with the idea you share with me.</i>
Timetables and plans	<i>The meeting starts at 9.00 tomorrow instead of 8.30. Breakfast is at 6.30. Don't be late.</i>
Present simple after when, before, etc.	<i>I will call you when I get home. Please get ready before she comes.</i>

c. *Spelling for third person singular*

- We add -s to the base form of most of the verbs:

Example: come => comes, record => records, walk => walks

- For some verbs, the spelling changes are:

	Verbs	Third person singular
Verbs ending in -ch, -ss, -sh, -x or -zz, we add -es.	watch	watches
	kiss	kisses
	finish	finishes



	mix	mixes
	buzz	buzzes
	hurry	hurries
Verbs ending in a consonant + -y we change y to <i>i</i> and add - <i>es</i> .	study	studies
	rely	relies
	play	plays
Verbs ending in a vowel + -y we just add -s.	say	says
	enjoy	enjoys
	have	has
<i>Have, go, do and be are irregular.</i>	go	goes
	do	does
	be	is

1.2. The present continuous tense

a. Form

+	I	Am	working
	you, we, they	Is	
	he, she, it	Are	
	I	am not/'m not	working
	you, we, they	is not/isn't	
	he, she, it	are not/aren't	



?+	Am	I	working?
	Is	he, she, it	
	Are	you, we, they	
?-	Isn't	he, she, it	working ???
	Aren't	you, we, they	

b. Uses and examples

Uses	Example
Events at the time of speaking	<i>She is trying to open the window but it is too tight.</i>
Temporary states	<i>Who's looking after the children while you're here?</i>
Repeated temporary events	<i>I'm not eating much chilli these days. I'm trying to cut down.</i>
Gradual change	<i>They're building a new statue in the park.</i>
Regular unplanned events	<i>Students are often talking in the class.</i>
Plans and arrangements	<i>We're moving to London in September.</i>

c. -ing form spelling

- We add -ing to the base form to make the -ing form for most verbs:

Be => being, eat => eating, play => playing



- For some other verbs the spelling changes as below.

	Verbs	-ing Form
When the verb ends in <i>-e</i> , we remove the <i>-e</i> and add <i>-ing</i> .	come	coming
	move	moving
The consonant is doubled when the verb ends in a vowel followed by a single consonant.	prefer	preferring
	rub	rubbing
we double the consonant when the verb ends in a vowel + <i>l</i> .	travel	travelling
	control	controlling
